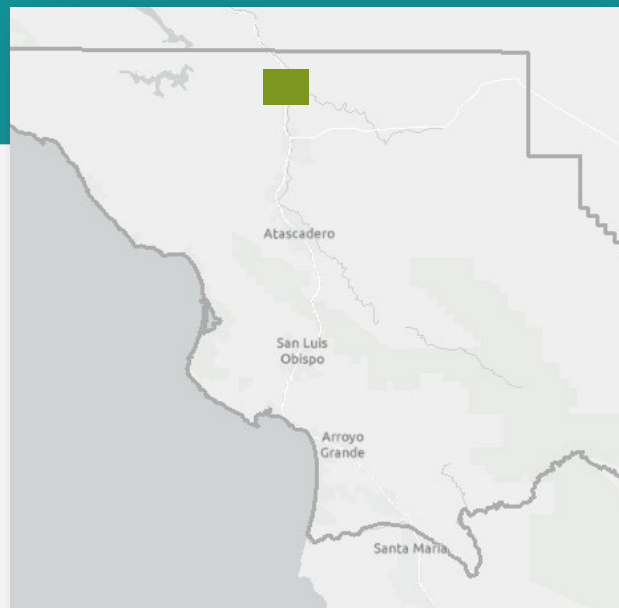


San Miguel

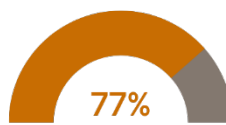

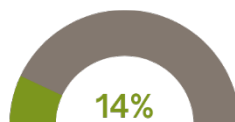
