Los Osos

Los Osos is an unincorporated community along the coast in northern San Luis Obispo County, California. It has <u>14,465</u> residents, with a population density of 1,133 people per square mile. Residents under the age of 18 account for 19% of the population, while 27% are ages 65 years and older.




