Oceano

Oceano is an unincorporated community along the coast in southern San Luis Obispo County, California. It has <u>7,183</u> <u>residents</u>, with a population density of 4,676 people per square mile. Residents under the age of 18 account for 21% of the population, while 27% are ages 65 years and older.

Health begins where people live, learn, work and play. From Oct 2024 through Mar 2025, the Healthy Communities Work Group met to analyze data around community conditions that impact health in SLO County, using it to select priority communities for focused efforts. 
