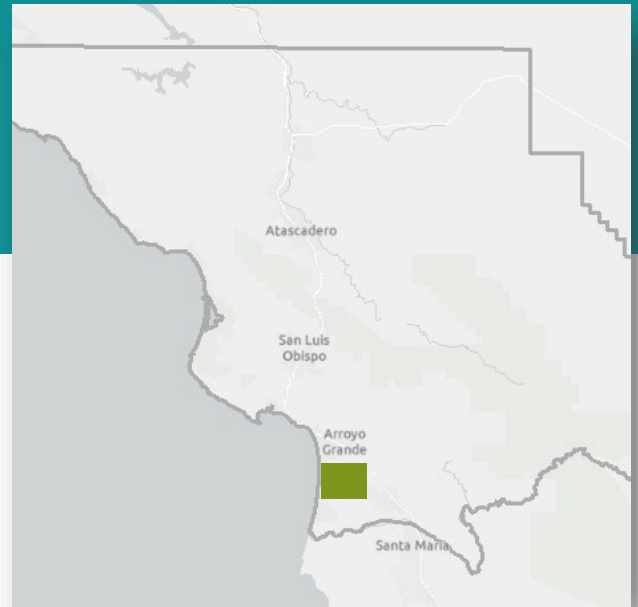


Nipomo

Nipomo is an unincorporated community in southern San Luis Obispo County, California. It has 18,176 residents, with a population density of 1,206 people per square mile. Residents under the age of 18 account for 24% of the population, while 18% are ages 65 years and older.



Health begins where people live, learn, work and play. 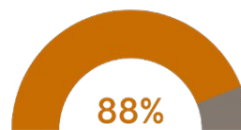

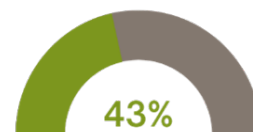
